DISA Direct Storefront (DDSF) 'Go-Live' release: Mobility and DSS – Here is what Mission Partners can expect!

DISA Direct Storefront 'Go-live' will roll out on October 13th with DoD Mobility Services and DSS as the first offering. DDSF will follow a "wave" rollout strategy that transitions the remaining 14 Network Services capabilities from DISA Direct Order Entry (DDOE) to DDSF. In this first release, Mission Partners (MP) can order DoD Mobility Service and DSS in a user friendly, e-Commerce-like platform.

DDSF release schedule and what to expect:

Important dates and Instructions:

DoD Mobility Service and DSS Capability – October 13th - First release of DISA Direct Storefront

- October 1st. - A full DISA Direct Database dump along with an export of the DoD Mobility Capability Telecommunication Service Requests (TSRs) will be provided to Lockheed Martin so they may begin importing/converting/associating records with the DDSF User Interface (UI).
- Prior to October 9th - DISA Direct will continue to allow customers to order DoD Mobility Capability type service (all type actions e.g. START, AMEND, CHANGE, CANCEL, DISCONTINUE)
- Between October 9th and 12th orders from DISA DIRECT will migration to DDSF over this weekend.
- On October 9th - The DoD Mobility Capability type service in DISA DIRECT will be marked obsolete.
- On October 10th – A full DISA Direct Database dump and TSR XML dump will be provided to Lockheed.

NOTE: Customers will not be able to order DoD Mobility Capability Services during the data migration period (October 9th – 12th).

A plan for Emergency type orders will be announced which would require an "after-the-fact" type order via DDSF.
